

Provisional dates of meetings for January to May 2019

It is proposed to set the dates of the final four meetings of the present Council in line with past practice, namely that the Council meets on the first Monday of the month.

This would mean the Council's final four meetings would be:

- Monday 7th January
- Monday 4th February
- Monday 4th March
- Monday 1st April.

It is proposed that all four meetings are held at 7.30pm in the Village Hall, Manor Road, South Hinksey.

Annual Council Meeting 2019

The law provides that in an election year “the annual meeting of a parish council shall be held on, or within fourteen days after, the day on which the councillors elected at that election take office” – which is the fourth day after that election.

This means, according to the Oxfordshire Association of Local Councils, that the annual council meeting should be held on, or within 14 days after, Tuesday 7th May. If the annual meeting were to be held on Monday 13th May, I am assured the Village Hall is available.

Meetings of the new Council

It is proposed that dates for meetings of the new council to be elected on Thursday 2nd May 2019 will be agreed at the annual meeting in May in line with normal practice in a parish council, which is to set dates at the annual meeting for the following twelve months.
