Confirmed costs for implementation of the 30mph speed limit together with the supporting highway measures breaks down as follows:

Static signs and gates (Signways):	£8062.02
Vehicle Activated Signs (OCC Street Lighting):	£9227.79
Vehicle Activated Signs Traffic Management (Skanska):	£1061.59
Road Marking (Skanska):	£1982.28
10% Design and Supervision fee:	£2033.37
Nett total:	£22367.05

Looking back at the figures Mark gave you originally, and if you remove the £2600

consultation fee which you have already paid, I note that the Nett total was estimated at £18,360.69.

I have a budget this year to help out with Parish funded schemes, therefore I will contribute the £4006.36 difference.

To confirm, the Nett cost to the Parish Council is **£18,360.69**.
