

Schedule of Burial Ground Fees

With effect from 1st January 2020

Exclusive Rights of Burial

Save in exceptional circumstances, Exclusive Rights of Burial will only be granted on the death of, and with respect to, a specified Category A or Category B Eligible Person (as defined below).

- Burial Plot (initial purchase for 50 years): £310
- Cremated Remains Plot (initial purchase for 50 years): £155
- Extension of Rights (by 25 years): £155

Grave Digging (which merely reflect our contractor's charges)

- Double depth:..... £450
- Single depth:..... £300
- Removal of spoil:..... £20
- Cremated Remains Plot:..... £100

Interment (Burial or Cremated Remains):

- Category A¹:..... £465
- Category B²:..... £930
- Category C³:..... £1,395
- Category D⁴:..... £1,860

Other Fees

- Memorial Approval: £130
- Second Inscription Approval: £30
- Search (per individual): £30
- Document copying (per document): £30
- Transfer of Ownership: £50

Arrangement of a Funeral and Erection of Memorial:

The Parish Council does not directly arrange funerals or the erection of memorials. Funeral Directors and Memorial Masons should be independently contracted and should be made aware of the Rules and Regulations of the Burial Ground.

¹ *Category A*: normally resident in the Parish for 10 years or more, ending either at the time of death or, for those who moved out of the Parish due to medical or care needs, within five years of death.

² *Category B*: normally resident in the Parish for less than 10 years ending either at the time of death or, for those who moved out of the Parish due to medical or care needs, within five years of death.

³ *Category C*: spouse, civil partner, or children of *Category A* or *Category B* who do not themselves qualify as *Category A* or *Category B*.

⁴ *Category D*: anybody who does not qualify as *Category A*, *Category B* or *Category C*.
